

QCLGA GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

August 25, 2022

President, Dena Knox, called the meeting to order. Dena asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the last general meeting as posted on the Website. Upon motion duly made by Roz Harrison and seconded by Debbie Riddell the Minutes from the last General Meeting were approved.

- Roz gave an update on the Give Back to the Community tournament to be held on November 3, 2022.
- Last time we had a meeting, questionnaires were put out on tables about different locations for the luncheon – Madera Patio, Patio outside the Grill, Pickle Ball area, private home, off-campus locations
- Taco Bar seems to be the favorite lunch
- In order to have banquet we need 45 ladies to sign up for lunch - 50 for bar at no charge. Checks need to be in earlier this year. The breakdown of the \$23.00 per person is \$17/18 plus tax and gratuity - \$23.00.

- Marie reported that the financials are on the Website.
- Renewals will start in October and will again be done through AGA. The AGA is not raising its rates.

- Location: Eagles Nest at Pebble Creek [3645 Clubhouse Drive, Goodyear, AZ 85395](#); a three-hour drive from Quail Creek
- Participating sites: Eagles Nest; Tuscany Falls, Saddlebrook Ranch, Robson Ranch and Quail Creek.
- We are allowed to bring two teams this year!
- Team selection will be based on two best scores from our five qualifiers; handicap requirements (of the Robson Challenge) and desire to play. Each team will consist of twelve players.

- Our pro and one pro shop employee may attend without cost (employee of Robson); Josh Wilks and Harvey Trott have been asked to participate.
- Entry fee is \$90/per person. The Board has approved paying 50% or \$45 per player.
- Further details are forthcoming e.g. format; handicap spread; pictures; car-pooling etc.
- Dena and Jacquie will contact players once the September qualifier has been played.

- The calendar was updated as of July 30th to include changes of coordinators.
- It will be cart-path-only for three weeks after overseed. As most of our tournaments are Pick Your Partner events during this time, it shouldn't be a big concern.

Handicap Chair: Jan Delcour and Nancy Hoppe

- Jan and Nancy thanked members for posting their scores. She advised that most do it all time but it is necessary to advise the Handicap Committee if a round is not completed or it is a practice round. We no longer use the clipboard outside the pro shop for that purpose.

Rules and Regulations: Bonny Wilcox

- Rule Reminders are submitted monthly for the Blast and Website.
- We have worked with QCMGA to revise our Local Rules which will be more detailed than the previous ones. The QCMGA, QCLGA, Couples, VA, etc. will adhere to these Local Rules in accordance with the Rules of Golf which should make playing in the different association events easier for all.
- The Hard Card - Model Local Rules - are local rules that have been approved to be used at Quail Creek should the need arise. For example, the Model Local Rule - MLR F-1 will allow players to get relief from furrows in the bunkers or if we know that Lift, Clean and Place will be necessary, it is spelled out for everyone
- The Model Local Rules will be posted on our Website but we recommend keeping a copy in your golf cart should you need to refer to it when out on the course. Copies will not be printed out for everyone.
- You will also notice the Local Rules look a little different but are more explanatory.
