### **Board Meeting Minutes**

#### **President Patti Harmon:**

The meeting was called to order at 3:04pm, Wednesday, April 29, 2026.

#### **Treasurer Debbie Dezell:**

- A summary overview of the current budget status was provided.
- There was a brief discuss of Robson Communities \$2500 contribution to the QCLGA Member/Guest Tournament. A portion of the Tournament food bill has not been paid due to the delay in receiving the \$2500 contribution. Beth Davis expressed the need for that particular expense to be reimbursed in the future, independent of the Robson contribution.

#### **Vice President Mary Newman**

The Lone Ranger Tournament next week will feature a cobb salad, rolls, and desert for \$20 per individual. The subsidy of approximately \$2 per meal will be absorbed by QCLGA

#### **Tournament – Bobbi Jo Rathvon**

- Future dates of course closure, recently announced, will affect QCLGA playdays. When all dates are final the playday calendar will be adjusted and members notified of the changes.
- Girls Just Want To Have Fun will change format in 2027 to a Skip Scramble.
- The Member/Guest Tournament went very well from the tournament standpoint (as well as all other aspects of the event).
- There is a large turnout for this week's Mixer with QCMGA.
- Interclub in May at Quail Creek will allow for 20 follow-the-field tee times.

- It was noted that last year the Pro Shop distributed bottled water to Inter-Club players as needed.
- Combo tees for ladies have now been available for six months. Those desiring to continue playing the combo tees will need to commit to same in May for the next six month period.

#### **Web Master - Stephenie Sacca**

- It was reiterated that July 31, 2026 is the date the website must be converted to an alternate system or additional fees will be assessed.
- The Executive Board has reviewed the significant progress completed on the new system and the conversion project is making good progress.
- The Website team requests that all Board members review any documents pertaining to their assignments and edit them for accuracy and completeness before the documents are moved to the new system.
- Group Spot will be used to support all QCLGA photos. Instructions on accessing and using Group Spot will be provided to members prior to the next General Meeting and the process will be reviewed at the next General Meeting.

#### **Standing Rules – Mary Newman**

Standing Rules and By-Laws will be reviewed by the committee and any changes will be presented to the membership.

#### **Handicap – Cheryl Opsal**

- Hole-By-Hole score posting is the preferred method recognized by the USGA and may become mandatory in the near future. The membership does not universally correctly use this method, therefore the committee will reenforce the importance of hole-by-hole posting at the next General Meeting.
- Posting of incomplete rounds is not being done correctly by some of the membership. The correct method of posting incomplete rounds will be demonstrated at the next General Meeting.
- The membership notifies the committee of an inordinate number of non-posted practice rounds. The industry consensus is a maximum six practice rounds on the course in a season. It was suggested that members notify the committee of an intended practice round prior to play. Any changes to the practice round policy will be clarified for membership vote in the proposed update to the Standing Rules.

The committee has been expanded to include Alicia Hiller, Linda Price and Becky Rice. Monthly meetings have been arranged to fully familiarize the new committee members with rules.
